Project 1 - Drama and Theatre Studies (Cost £1,000)

Due to recent changes in examination specifications, it has become increasingly important to video record the work of drama students.

Boys are examined on their performance skills within their drama course. They are also able to use video footage to evaluate their personal and group performances which helps them in this process.

Project 2 – Science (Cost £4,000)

Science at QEH is thriving and we are looking to extend the activities we offer beyond our normal teaching commitments.

The School has entered one Sixth Form team for a national robotics competition organised by the Computer and Engineering Departments of the University of Southampton. The interest and enthusiasm shown by the Sixth Form scientists have been overwhelming and we would welcome support with the purchase of equipment to allow us to enter more teams. Biology numbers in the Sixth Form are at an all time high and we are looking to give our biologists the opportunity to extend their knowledge of DNA profiling with the use of gel-electrophoresis techniques.

We would like to purchase several kits containing power pac mini power supplies, GT electrophoresis chambers, adjustable volume digital micropipettes and well chambers. Your support for these activities will help boys appreciate some aspects of scientific investigation that we do not normally cover in timetabled lessons in the laboratory.

Project 3 - Outdoor Pursuits (Cost £15,000)

We would like to thank all who donated to this project last year. We are now looking for further funds to complete this exciting project.

QEH Outdoor Pursuits would benefit enormously from a Land Rover. A sturdy four-wheel drive vehicle would enhance the range and type of expedition we could offer. QEH has cancelled expeditions every year due to snow.

This is purely for safety reasons, as small roads have been rendered impassable for the minibus, making it very difficult to monitor pupils on the moors and react safely to emergency situations.

A Land Rover would improve the efficiency and running of all expeditions. Transporting equipment, monitoring pupils and safety back-up are all key areas which are presently very difficult to achieve with minibuses. We currently hire a van to transport kit, although the larger vehicles struggle to access remote locations.

Finally, the Land Rover would reflect positively on the School and underline our professional approach to the activities that we undertake. QEH Outdoor Pursuits are expanding into many different areas over the next two years including climbing, caving and water sports. Efficient transport is paramount to the success of all Outdoor Pursuits.
