Participating in team tours which travel to many parts of the world

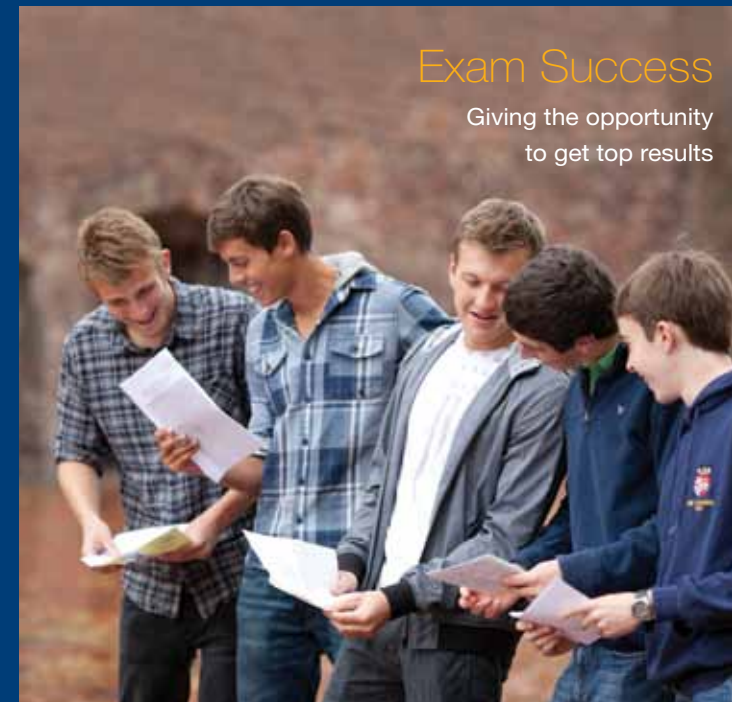

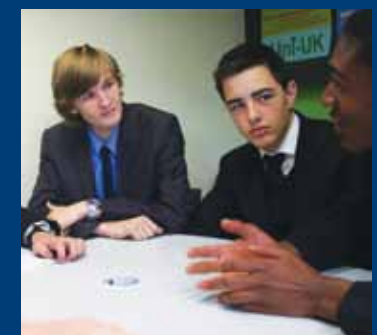
