

Learning Enhancement



Pupils who have support needs either because they have gifts and talents which require support for extension beyond the curriculum or those who have a diagnosed learning problem such as dyslexia or dyspraxia, or need help with handwriting and spelling, are referred to the Learning Enhancement Centre.

Provision

- Identification/testing
- Extension opportunities:
 - Notification of National & International learning opportunities
 - Nomination for the UK Young Gifted & Talented programme
 - Advice for parents of gifted pupils
- Drop-in facility for all pupils 4 sessions weekly (lunch or after school)
- Specific lunchtime support sessions for identified pupils:
 - Workshops in areas such as: 'Writing Organisation', 'Reading Between the Lines' and Maths topics
 - Sixth form volunteers assist a member of staff deliver this service
 - Staff are regularly given updates of those attending
- Testing for Access Arrangements for exams
- Advice for parents of pupils with learning difficulties.
